

## Exam Sample Questions

### Examples of ASFP Governance

In your own words describe:

- a. 3 of 9 member in training obligations (3 marks)
- b. 3 of 14 obligations sponsors have when sponsoring a member in training (3 marks)

In your own words briefly describe 5 of the 19 generic procedural steps for conducting a disciplinary hearing. (5 marks)

In your own words describe 3 of the 7 goals of the continuing competency program and describe the requirements for maintaining competency. (6 marks)

### Example of problem scenario (5 marks)

**The intent of the problem scenarios is to test candidates in regard to their understanding of issues from a professional or ethical perspective and not designed to test technical knowledge of the matters in question**

You are in charge of planting a 100 ha block that was winter cut with white spruce container stock. The stock was cached there in the winter time and when you fly out with your planting crew and open the boxes the seedlings are moldy.

- a) What steps do you take to determine if you should plant the seedlings in the ground?
- b) If you do plant the moldy stock, what steps would you take?

### Examples of provincial legislation questions

In your own words describe 5 of the 20 purposes for which regulatory by-laws that may be made by council of the ASFP. (5 marks)

List 5 of the 8 legal requirements of a scaling plan. (5 marks)

In your own words describe what a Forest Management Plan must do to the minister's satisfaction. (5 marks)

**With respect to operational planning briefly describe the road classes including specifications. (6 marks)**

**Briefly describe:**

- a. when to report a discharge (2 marks)**
- b. who must report a discharge (2 marks)**
- c. if a deposit of silt or gravel stemming from an installed stream crossing is deemed a discharge (1 mark)**

### **Examples of federal legislation questions**

**Describe the prohibitions when carrying out work in, on, over, under, through or across navigable waters. (3 marks)**

**In accordance with federal legislation what are the general prohibitions on a person under measures to protect wildlife species that are listed as extirpated, endangered or threatened as well as any part or derivative of such species. (4 marks)**
